Calculation of APS Score

APS Score: The results obtained in six 20 credit NSC subjects are used in computation of the APS score. Life Orientation is excluded. A Minimum score of 24 is required.

Duration: Minimum of 4 Years

This means that prospective students who comply with the minimum requirements may not necessarily be admitted to the courses in question.
