Introduction

Mode of Delivery

Prospective students who are full-time employed in the education sector and interested in furthering their studies as distance students may apply for the following BEdHons Programmes through the Unit for Open Distance Learning:

- BEdHons in Mathematics Education
- BEdHons in Special Needs Education
- BEdHons in Life Orientation

The academic offering is based on the philosophy of self-directed and self-regulated learning. Teaching and learning is managed through the NWU's eFundi Learning Management System, downloads on UODL's website, whiteboard sessions and other electronic means of communication.

Academics in the Faculty of Education are responsible for the teaching, learning and assessment of modules in a BEdHons programme. NWU's academics at all three campuses set examination papers to ensure that all NWU's students are meeting the required module outcomes. The examination papers are fully aligned in both contact and distance modes of delivery.

Distance students write examinations at the NWU

examination centres in South Africa and Namibia.

English is the medium of instruction for all distance programmes.
