1 INTRODUCTION

The BA in Public Governance with Policing Practice programme within the Unit for Open Distance Learning (UODL) aims to provide students with the knowledge, skills and attitudes to live and work in a globally interdependent world and with the support services to help them succeed. This requires a conscious, purposeful, sustained and social-constructivist focus on the actual learning of students that may take place because of their interactions in specific study-related groups. For this reason, this academic programme also seeks to foster inclusivity and to develop a sense of personal and social responsibility and ethical conduct in and amongst our students by encouraging involvement in environmental affairs, as well as in community and public service. It endeavours to offer and cultivate a teaching-learning environment that is hospitable to diverse socio-conventional and linguistic interests.

- Open Distance Learning is based on the principle that a student can apply any time of the year and register for either the first or second semester according to fixed dates as indicated in this booklet . The minimum duration of the programme is 3 years and the maximum duration is 5 years.
- The language of tuition is English and contact sessions are conducted in English.
- You need internet access and all communication wrt this programme will be on eFundi. Students should also communicate with lecturers (if needed) on eFundi. See <http://efundi.nwu.ac.za/portal>
- There are videos/u-tube guidance on eFundi to guide you with regard to all technical/web challenges that you may encounter. See <http://efundi.nwu.ac.za/portal/site/!gateway/page/895c0368-a3bd-48fd-b4e6-21127c62e572> - for any technical query wrt eFundi.
- Please distinguish between a contact class and an examination centre. There are 12 contact classes for this programme only and students can apply to any one of the 111 examination centres to write examinations.
- Contact classes are presented by means of interactive whiteboards. Lectures can also be followed on a personal computer if students have access to the internet. All modules presented by means of interactive whiteboards are recorded and stored on the internet for students and facilitators to access at a later stage. See <http://distance.nwu.ac.za/downloads>
- Students are supported by means of a Call Centre for general enquiries from Monday – Friday, 08:00 -16:30 at 018 285 5900.
- Your student number and a clear indication that you are a distance student must be indicated on all correspondence.
- Students have a first and second examination opportunity. The second opportunity must be utilised during the next examination period. See A-Rules.
- A valid participation mark gives the student access to two examination opportunities, after which a student must generate a new participation mark by re-registering for the module. See A-Rules.
- Study material will be delivered to the courier address you have indicated on your application. It is important that you can receive the material at the address to avoid disappointment.

3 PROGRAMME INFORMATION

3.1 GENERAL AIM

The qualification consists of a minimum of 384 credits divided into 28 modules. These modules include fundamental modules and core and compulsory modules.

3.2 ADMISSION REQUIREMENTS

- Applicants should be in possession of a Grade 12 National Senior Certificate with university exemption.
- Applicants should have obtained an “E” symbol at HG in the language of tuition, i.e. English, with an M score of 14.
- Students who completed Std 10 (Senior Certificate), without endorsement, may apply to HESA (see Universities South Africa (HESA) website Universities South Africa <http://mb.usaf.ac.za/>) for possible conditional exemption. It is your responsibility to apply for conditional or foreign exemption via the University of South Africa.
- Applicant should have an APS count of at least 25 and a Level 4 for English.
- Deserving students, as approved by the faculty, may be considered for Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) if they have 5 years’ experience with the SAPS.

7 EFUNDI

eFundi is the electronic learning platform where individual module sites are created and all academic information is uploaded, including assignments, important dates, additional reading material, assignment feedback, participation and examination marks, etc. All registered students have access to eFundi. When you sign up to use eFundi, your username is your student number. For the first time you will need to use your RSA ID/passport number as your password. After you have submitted your assignment on eFundi, you will receive a notification via e-mail. As soon as students are registered, they should automatically have access to all the eFundi module sites. 8 ASSESSMENT INFORMATION

8.1 ASSIGNMENTS

Two assignments per module must be electronically submitted on eFundi. Assignments e-mailed to lecturers will not be taken into account. Assignment marks lead to a participation mark, which gives you admission to the exam provided that you have at least a 40% participation mark. Assignments that are submitted late will have to stand over to the next semester. Results from assignments received late or via e-mail to lecturers will not be captured.

8.2 MODULE MARK

A module mark is a mark calculated according to a formula that is determined from time to time for each module in terms of faculty rules, based on the participation mark and the examination mark awarded to a student in a module; provided that the weight of the participation mark in the above mentioned formula may not be less than 30% or more than 70%.

In calculating the module mark for all modules (except when stated otherwise in a particular module), the participation mark for modules in the Policing Practice programme carries a weight of 50% and the examination mark a weight of 50% towards the final module mark.
