**Admission to BEd Degree: Language Requirements**

In addition to the admission requirements indicated in the undergraduate Yearbook of the Faculty of Education as well as in the BEd brochure, prospective BEd students must adhere to the following language requirements to be considered for admission into the BEd degree:

**1. BEd Foundation Phase**

- 1.1 Minimum of 50% achieved for both Home/First language as well as First Additional /Second language subjects in Grade 12 (matric).
- 1.2 Both the applicant's Home/First language as well as the First Additional /Second Language in Grade 12 (matric) must form part of the group of approved languages, offered in the BEd Foundation Phase program, as indicated below:

**1. BEd Intermediate Phase**

- 1.1 Minimum of 50% achieved for both Home/First language as well as First Additional /Second language subjects in Grade 12 (matric).
