Method of Delivery

This is a unique and creative way, in which you yourself determine the place, time and tempo of your learning. It allows you to study full-time while you work and gives new momentum to your career through professional training. Electronic as well as telephonic support is available, with personal contact facilitation at learning support centres if you desire it.

The qualification programme is completed on a correspondence basis with direct contact between the lecturer and the student through the NWU’s eFundi platform. Study material is available electronically. Students are responsible to buy prescribed text books. All examination papers are set, assessed and moderated by NWU staff members.

Examinations are written at NWU examination centres nationwide, subject to covid regulations. Studies are available in both Afrikaans and English.

Application

Applications close 30 September for the 1st semester of the next year. A student can also apply in April to start in the second semester. Application is done online at <https://distance.nwu.ac.za/apply-online>

Registration

Students whose applications were successful, register annually through the Unit for Distance Learning. The process is online and involves payment of the prescribed registration fee and minimum payable fee. A proof of registration will be issued to the student by the Unit for Distance Learning as soon as the student is registered.

Programme of study	Duration	Admission requirements	Further studies
<p>BTh Hons (NQF 8 qualification)</p> <p>This is an advanced qualification in Christian Theology. The student will be further equipped for ecclesiastical ministry in a multicultural context. The student will be able to do valid interpretation and application of the Bible (with exegetical tools). The student will also be equipped for pastoral counselling and will be able to think and act in an ethical manner, be value driven, and engaged in community development.</p>	<p>The minimum study period for this qualification is one year. The maximum period is three years. In extraordinary cases, students can apply for an extension of the study period.</p>	<p>Admission requirement for this programme is a BTh degree with an average of at least 60% in the third year. Students who have completed a B degree that includes sufficient theological subjects can apply for BTh Hons. If a student's B degree does not include theological subjects, he/she can enroll for the B-Status in Theology. After successful completion of the B-Status exam, the student can enroll for BTh Hons.</p>	<p>The BTh Hons is an advanced degree in Christian Theology, which builds on a first degree in Theology / Biblical Studies or an equivalent qualification. Successful completion of the programme provides articulation possibilities to a MTh degree.</p>
